For 2025 All-Ohio State Team consideration based on the 2024 shooting season, a shooter must submit his/her application to the OSTA Secretary by November 1st. They must also compete in all of their Zone events (400 targets) and the State Championship HAA event. Shooters must meet the target requirement of 2,500 single, 1500 HC and 1,000 doubles. The target requirements for Jr., Sub-Jr., Lady II & Sr. Vet are 2,000 singles, 1000 HC, and 500 doubles. The minimum composite average to qualify is 85%.

Doubles and Singles Zone Teams

Zone Teams will compete concurrently in the respective State Championship events June 22 and 23, 2024.

Singles Teams consist of the two top scores from each class AA-A-B-C-D and one each Lady, Vet, Sr. Vet, Jr., and Sub Jr. with one alternate in each class and each category.

Doubles Teams consist of the two top scores from each class plus one each Lady, Vet, Sr. Vet, Jr. and Sub Jr. with one alternate each class and each category.

Ties shoot-off for team positions. Alternates determined (if not in event shoot-offs as 2nd, 3rd, etc.) by sub-events, from first to last. If still tied, then by long run, from first to last.

Shooters who qualify for their Zone Team in Singles or Doubles or qualify as the alternate, will be awarded a Zone Team hat at the Zone Shoot. **At the State Shoot, the members of the winning singles Zone Team and the winning doubles Zone Team, will each receive \$100.00.** The results will be posted at the score sheet annex.

Event III – OSTA trophy to Champion, Runner-up, High Lady, Veteran, Sr. Veteran, Junior, Sub-Jr., and 5 yardage group Champions (19-20), (21-22), (23-24), (25-26) and (27).

Event IV – HAA - 400 targets
HAA - combined scores from Events I, II and III. \$25 to Champion each class based on Singles classification.

The hosting gun clubs will determine and post their program options.

Entries will close at the discretion of the Directors.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Present updated A.T.A. average card-
A.T.A. rule book Section II C4.
- Classification for this shoot is based on 2023 average. Current year targets/average will be used solely for the purpose of establishing minimum target requirements.
- Shooter must shoot penalty if they registered less than 500 targets in a respective discipline—Singles, Handicap, or Doubles between 9/01/22 and 5/18/2024.
- Singles %: AA-97 and over, A-94 and under 97, B-91 and under 94, C-88 and under 91, D-under 88, penalty- B (min. one class move up with a min. class B).
- Doubles %: AA-93 and over, A-89 and under 93, B-85 and under 89, C-78 and under 85, D-under 78, penalty-B (min. one class move up with a min. class B).
- Handicap penalty: 2 yard min. penalty-25 yard max. or current yardage, whichever is greater. For Senior Vets, handicap penalty yardage is waived for this shoot.

Gun Clubs must provide payout sheets to those participants receiving a check by mail pursuant to ATA rule Section 8, B3 and shall post the names of all Zone Championship Team members.

To the O.S.T.A. Secretary: **Zone Directors** must submit names, addresses and ATA numbers for all Doubles and Singles Team members and Alternates in class and category and score of each **BY JUNE 1ST**. Results must be posted by the hosting gun clubs and will be on ohiotrap.com.
